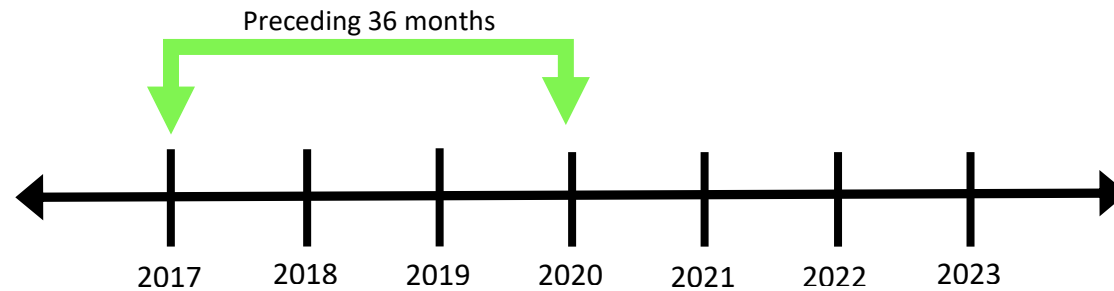




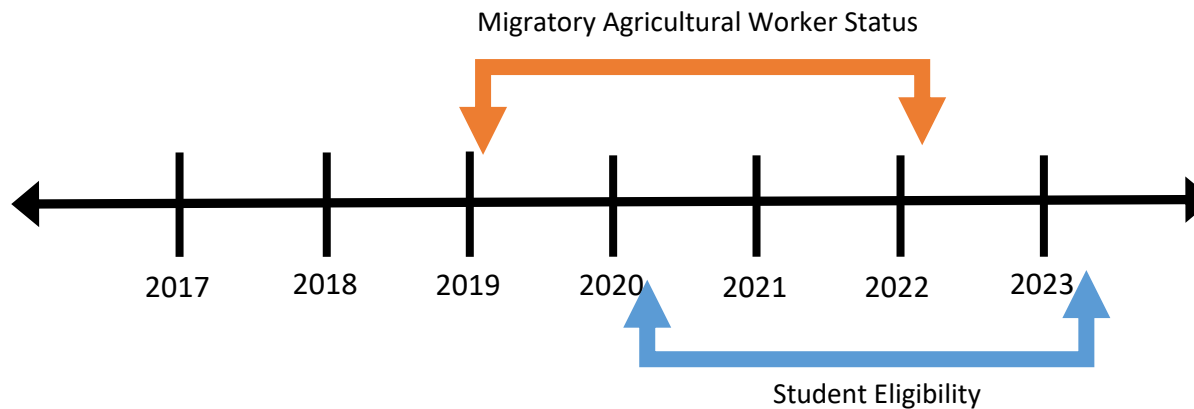

Subsequent Moves



The Louisiana MEP recruiter visits the family on January 27th, 2020. All moves that will factor into eligibility and recorded on the COE must occur within the preceding 36 months of the **Eligibility Interview**.



The family made **Qualifying Moves** from Dallas, Texas to Hammond, Louisiana in January 2017, 2018 and 2019 and soon after those moves, engaged in **Qualifying Work** laying plastic for strawberries. The father's status as a **Migratory Qualifying Worker** will last 36 months after each of those dates. Represented below in orange is the last time the father made a **Qualifying Move** and engaged in **Qualifying Work** in 2019.



The children made a **Qualifying Move** with their father, who is a **Migratory Qualifying Worker**, on January 25th, 2020 from Dallas, TX to Hammond, LA. This will result in a new **Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD)** of 1/25/2020 and three **Migratory Children** represented in blue above. Any **Qualifying Move** the children make as, with, to join, or precede a **Migratory Agricultural Worker** will result in a new **QAD**. Based on this information, if the family does not move again, their End of Eligibility will be January 24th, 2023.
